

Volunteer Disability & Inclusion Coach – Part-time

MK Dons Sport & Education Trust are seeking new volunteer football coaches to support and deliver to our Disability and Inclusion football teams. This is an excellent opportunity for a driven football coach to work in direct affiliation with a professional football club in Milton Keynes. At MK Dons SET we currently have multiple age groups ranging from under 8's to varied ability levels of adult disability football.

A MK Dons SET volunteer coach will be expected to take progressive training sessions as well as attend BOBi tournament days and other fixtures throughout the season. Certain administrative duties will be required with regards to taking registers and other basic administrative tasks. Full kit and equipment will be provided for the successful candidate.

Working hours are varied and will be discussed with the successful applicant. Typically, Sunday evenings are training days with sessions running from 5pm-8pm. However, due to the current COVID-19 situation this is subject to change. MK Dons SET are taking every precaution in the safe resumption of grass roots football, including temperature checks, health screening and having cleaning equipment and PPE available at all times.
