This document will be updated on a regular basis as and when we receive more information.

Stadium MK is delighted to welcome My Chemical Romance to Milton Keynes in May 2022.

The aim of this guide is to provide visitors with the information needed to plan their journey and detail the additional traffic management measures that will be in place in order to allow visitors to access the stadium as safely and quickly as possible.

In view of the larger attendance, we would ask all visitors to plan their journey in advance and leave as much time as possible on the evening for their arrival.

The following information and map should assist in providing information on the various methods of travel to the event.

By Train

Milton Keynes Central Railway Station is the recommended station for train travel and is included on the route of the Event Day Shuttle Service to the stadium. The Shuttle service will **commence at 13:00hrs** and the return journey from the stadium will operate **from 21:00hrs until 00:30**. The return fare is £9 per person plus £1 booking fee. Please see full details below under Event Day Shuttle Service. Bletchley Railway Station is approx. 30-minute walk from Stadium MK and is not included on the Shuttle Service.

By Bus

Stadium MK is served by local bus services **6/100/150/310/F70/F77** normally operated in the evenings to provide connections between the Stadium and Milton Keynes Central Railway Station, Central Milton Keynes and Bletchley Bus Station (a 5 min walk from Bletchley rail station). Services will be redirected from **18:00hrs** via Bond Avenue when Saxon Street is subject to a road closure. By Event Day Shuttle Service

The Event Day Shuttle Service will operate specifically for this concert between Central Milton Keynes and the stadium, starting from the Bus Stop on Elder Gate (postcode **MK9 1BE**). The return fare is £9 per person plus a £1 booking fee. Tickets can be pre purchased online here: <https://bit.ly/MCRTravel2022> or on the day from the ticket booth signposted near the bus stop. Please note that no tickets will be sold on the buses themselves.

This will be a rolling service **commencing at 13:00hrs**, with the **last bus leaving Elder Gate at 19:30hrs**. The **return journey** will operate from **Grafton Street/Fitness First bus stop from 21:00hrs**. The **last bus will leave at 00:30hrs**. The service will be operated on behalf of the stadium by Country Lion.

There is ample parking provision in the public car parks around the pick-up point at Milton Keynes Central Railway Station. Parking charges vary, so please ensure you check car park signage when parking.



By Car, Stadium Parking

On-site parking spaces are available to purchase online here: <https://bit.ly/MCRTravel2022>. The parking charge for this event is £20 plus booking fee. You will be prompted to include your vehicle registration which will be scanned on entry to the car park to speed entry. We would advise that you have your e-ticket available, either printed or on a smart phone, in case of any issues. You will be directed to use the Saxon Street entrance. The best postcode for this entry is **MK1 1ET**. The **Stadium car park will be open from 1pm**.

PLEASE NOTE THAT NO PARKING WILL BE AVAILABLE TO PURCHASE AT THE POINT OF ENTRY TO THE STADIUM SITE.

PLEASE NOTE THAT NO VEHICLES WILL BE PERMITTED TO LEAVE THE STADIUM FOR 30 MINUTES AFTER THE CONCERT TO ALLOW PEDESTRIANS TO EXIT SAFELY.

A number of off-site car parking sites are available as indicated in the section below.

Blue Badge Holders

On-site parking spaces for Blue Badge holders are available to purchase online here: <https://bit.ly/MCRTravel2022>. The parking charge for this event is £20 plus booking fee and a limited number of both wide bays and standard bays have been allocated as close to the stadium as possible. You will be prompted to include your vehicle registration which will be scanned on entry to the car park to speed entry. We would advise that you have your e-ticket available, either printed or on a smart phone, in case of any issues, and your blue badge should be displayed in your vehicle. You will be directed to use the Saxon Street entrance. The best postcode for this entry is **MK1 1ET**.

PLEASE NOTE THAT NO DISABLED PARKING WILL BE AVAILABLE ON SITE WITHOUT PRE-BOOKING.

PLEASE NOTE THAT NO VEHICLES WILL BE PERMITTED TO LEAVE THE STADIUM FOR 30 MINUTES AFTER THE CONCERT TO ALLOW PEDESTRIANS TO EXIT SAFELY.

Off-site Parking

Park & Walk – Bond Estates MK1 1SW **SOLD OUT**

A Park & Walk car park will operate from Bond Estates (**MK1 1SW**). Your vehicle registration will be scanned on entry to the car park to speed entry. We would advise that you have your e-ticket available, either printed or on a smart phone, in case of any issues. This official site will **open at 17:00hrs and close at 00:30hrs** and will be manned throughout the event.

Park & Stride - National Bowl MK - MK5 8RR

Parking is available at the National Bowl MK as a Park & Stride service (approx. 30 min walk), available to book in advance for £10 plus £1 booking fee at <https://bit.ly/MCRTravel2022>. You will be prompted to include your vehicle registration which will be scanned on entry to the car park to speed entry. We would advise that you have your e-ticket available, either printed or on a smart phone, in case of any issues. This official site will be manned throughout the event. The car park will be open between **14:00 – 01:00hrs**.

Central Milton Keynes Public Car Parks

There is ample parking provision in the public car parks around the Central Milton Keynes Railway Station which is serviced by the Event Day Shuttle Service pick-up point at Elder Gate (postcode **MK9 1LR**). Parking charges vary, so please ensure you check car park signage when parking.

As detailed above, the Event Day Shuttle Service will operate **from 13:00hrs** and travel directly to the stadium. The return journey will operate from Grafton Street/Fitness First bus stop **from 21:00hrs**. The return journey costs £9 plus £1 booking fee and tickets can be pre purchased online via <https://bit.ly/MCRTravel2022> or on the night from the ticket booth signposted near the bus stop. Please note that no tickets will be sold on the buses themselves.

Local Industrial Parking

A **limited amount** of on-street parking is available in the local industrial areas around the stadium site. Visitors are requested to park legally and considerately and respect our neighbours by not causing disruption to their homes or businesses, some of which operate 24-hours a day. Please note that Parking Enforcement will be in operation.

Visitors should not park in the surrounding residential areas where parking is limited and restricted for residents use.

Retail Car Parks

Parking on the **MK1 Shopping & Leisure Parks, Fitness First, ASDA and IKEA sites are restricted for customers only (2 hours max)** and ANPR cameras are in operation which may result in penalty notices being issued. Traffic management and Parking Enforcement will be in operation.



Drop Off

Drop-Off Points are located adjacent to **Gate 6 accessed via Grafton Street** and adjacent to **Gate 4 accessed via the Saxon Street entrance**. Please follow signage and steward directions to the Drop-Off Zone. No dropping off is allowed within the road network for any reason.



Pick Up

A designated pick up point for private vehicles is located in the **MK1 Shopping Park Car Park accessed via Grafton Street** only. Please follow signage and steward directions. You are advised that Road Closures will be in operation on Saxon Street and Grafton Street either side of the stadium. *Please note that no vehicles will be permitted to leave the stadium for 30 minutes after the concert to allow pedestrians to exit safely.*



By Taxi

There will be **NO dedicated Hackney Carriage point** on site and the standard drop off/pick up points should be used.

A large number of Private Hire companies operate in Milton Keynes and must be pre-booked.

There is **NO designated Private Hire Pick-Up point** on the stadium site, and it is suggested that arrangements are made with drivers to pick up at Asda or Ikea off Bletcham Way which is not subject to a road closure order.

By Foot

The stadium is accessible via the **Milton Keynes Redway network via Grafton Street (V6) and Saxon Street (V7)**. For your own safety, please keep to footpaths and underpasses.
