The aim of this guide is to provide visitors with the information needed to plan their journey and detail the additional traffic management measures that will be in place in order to allow visitors to access the stadium as safely and quickly as possible.

In view of the capacity attendance, we would ask all visitors to plan their journey in advance and leave as much time as possible on the evening for their arrival.

Travel Methods



By Train

Milton Keynes is serviced by two railway stations: Milton Keynes Central and Bletchley. Services operated by Avanti West Coast (<https://delayrepay.avantiwestcoast.co.uk>) and London Northwest Railway (<https://www.londonnorthwesternrailway.co.uk>) operate into Milton Keynes Central, and London Northwestern only into Bletchley. Please ensure that you consult the timetable to confirm the time of the trains for return travel and allow sufficient to reach the station.



By Car **Sold out**

On site parking has now **sold out**. If you have purchased parking, you will be directed to use the Saxon Street entrance and the best postcode for this entry is **MK1 1ET**. Your registration plate will be scanned on entry to the car park, but we would advise that you have your e-ticket available, either printed or on a smart phone, in case of any issues and would ask that you use the designated entry route into the stadium for your individual car park.

Off site car parking is available as indicated in the section below.



Blue Badge Holders **Sold out**

Disabled parking is chargeable and is subject to availability. Pre-booking is essential via parkthecarhere.com (<https://parkthecarhere.com/CarPark.aspx?eventid=7713>). Your registration plate will be scanned on entry to the car park, but we would advise bringing a copy of your e-ticket, either printed or available on your smart phone. You will need to bring your valid Blue Badge which will be checked on entry against the passengers in the vehicle.

By Coach and Minibus

Coach and minibus parking will be accommodated in the Coach park adjacent to McDonalds, entry via Saxon Street. Spaces may be prebooked online via parkthecarhere.com at a cost of £30 and £15 respectively plus booking fee (<https://parkthecarhere.com/CarPark.aspx?eventid=7713>). There may be some limited capacity on the day at a price of £35 and £20 respectively.

Extra Arrangements

All visitors entering the site should accept this as a condition of entry.

A5 Northbound – Please note that the sliproad to the A5 Northbound from Redmoor Roundabout is closed due to essential bridge repair works by Network Rail. One lane of Grafton Street at the approach to Redmoor Roundabout is also closed.



Off Site Parking

Bond Estates Park & Walk (MK1 1PA) **Sold out**

Park & Walk car parks will operate from Bond Estates on Mount Farm which is a **10-15 minute walk**. For those who have pre-booked, please have your e-ticket available, either printed or on a smart phone, in case of any issues. These official sites will be manned throughout the event. **Access to these car parks is from 5.30pm only.**

National Bowl Park & Stride (MK5 8RR)

A Park & Stride car park will operate from the National Bowl which is a **30-35 minute walk**. This car park may be pre-booked online (<https://parkthecarhere.com/CarPark.aspx?eventid=7713>) at a cost of £7 plus booking fee or will be available on the day at a cost of £10. Your registration plate will be scanned on entry to the car park, but we would advise bringing a copy of your e-ticket, either printed or available on your smart phone. This official site will be manned throughout the event.

Local Industrial Parking

A limited amount of on-street parking is available in the local industrial areas around the stadium site. Visitors are requested to park legally and considerately and respect our neighbours by not causing disruption to their homes or businesses. Please note that Parking Enforcement will be in operation.

Visitors should not park in the surrounding residential areas where parking is limited and restricted for residents use.

Site Retailers

Parking on the MK1 Shopping Park, Fitness First, ASDA and IKEA sites are restricted for customers only. Traffic management and Parking Enforcement will be in operation.



By Drop Off / Pick Up

Drop-Off Points are located adjacent to **Gate 6** accessed **via Grafton Street** and adjacent to **Gate 4** accessed via the **Saxon Street** entrance. Please follow signage and steward directions to the Drop-Off Zone. No dropping off is allowed within the road network for any reason.

Pick up after the game will be at the **MK1 Shopping Park** with access via **Grafton Street only**. Please follow signage and steward directions. You are advised to arrive before the end of the second game as the site will be locked down to allow pedestrians to exit safely.

By Taxi

There is **NO dedicated taxi point** on site and taxis/private hire vehicles must **drop off** at the **Gate 6** and **Gate 4** drop off points.

A large number of Private Hire companies operate in Milton Keynes and must be pre-booked. It is suggested that you arrange to meet any private hire vehicle off site at the adjacent Asda or Ikea stores to avoid congestion after the game. All vehicles arriving on site after the game will be directed to the MKI Shopping Park car park.

By Bike

Bicycle parking facilities are available upon the stadium footprint located at **Gate 1** and **Gate 5**.



By Foot

The stadium is accessible via the Milton Keynes Redway network via Grafton Street (V6) and Saxon Street (V7). For your own safety, please keep to footpaths and underpasses.

Traffic Management Measures

The following traffic control measures will be in place around the stadium for the safety of visitors:

- No Parking Zones will be in force on Grafton Street and Saxon Street and tow vehicles will be in operation.
- Pedestrian walkways on site will be barriered to minimize interaction of pedestrians with vehicles.
- Traffic will be held on site for a period after the event to allow pedestrians to exit safely.
